Nos. 27, 28 and 29 and nos. 450-451 were severally published together under the respective dates "1885, Juillet-Août" and "Juin et Juillet 1900." The twenty-fifth year has a "Numéro Jubilaire" of "XXXVI" pages. There are paper wrappers to nos. 1-12 and nos. 13-16. Nos. 1-12 are folio and nos. 13-16 are octavo. Nos. 1-12 are printed in red ink. Nos. 13-16 are printed in black ink. Nos. 1-12 have a title-page and a list of contents in octavo size in 1867.
