It was then placed as Treasurer, but I never touched or ever saw a penny of the money subscribed, or had anything at all to do with the pecuniary transactions.—C. W. Viner." A copy of the Prospectus was published in the advertisement pages of the "Stamp Collector's Magazine" of July, 1864, and a notice, with further particulars of the objects of the Company, appeared in the advertisement pages of the same magazine of August, 1864.
