In a review of this work that appeared in the "Stamp collector's magazine" of July, 1863, it is stated to be "simply a verbatim et literatim transcript of the third edition of Mount Brown's manual . . . but little or no mischief will accrue to Mr. Brown, as it has been arranged that all existing copies of the work are to be surrendered to him for destruction".
