No. 1 and the "numero di saggio" were printed by lithography and nos. 2-12 were printed by a hand multiplying press and nos. 6-8 and no. 11 were produced by autographic lithography at Saluzzo. Nos. 6, 7, 9 and 10, and 13 and 14 were severally published together. Nos. 1 and 6-8 have no date and nos. 11-14 bear the month of issue but no year. No. 8 has "anno 2" in place of "anno 1". *Mis.
