Nos. 1, 2, and 3, vol. VII, were published together. Nos. 1, 2, 4 and 5 of vol. VII, each contain a supplement of four pages of a philatelic novel: "Folately" by Ad. Reamer. Nos. 3 is a quarto number 8*g*, except on the paper wrapper, which is correct, and nos. 1 and 2 of vol. II, do not bear "whole no. 7" or "whole no. 8".
