The wrapper of nos. 1 and 2 of 1901 has the date

printed "Noviembre y Diciembre de 1900" but above this in white ink is printed "Enero y Febrero de 1901." And the earlier date is struck through with a bar in violet. This journal commenced publication in 1892, but the numbers issued previous to July 15, 1899, are non-philatelic. This was the first philatelic journal published in Cuba.
