Nos. 31 and 32 are dated, respectively, "1 Janvier, 1896" and "25 Janvier, 1896" and there is no number for February, 1896. No. 1-29 were printed at Amiens, no. 30 at Mirecourt, and commencing with no. 33 the journal was printed at Caen. No. 112 is found printed on yellow and also on white paper.
