\* Vols. I-III. are 1 1/2 inches and the remainder are 1 1/2 inches. Nos. 327-533 were published by J. A. Mekeel at St. Louis, nos. 554-689 by Mekeel-Redfield-Severn Co., at New York, and nos. 689 and 690 by the same company at Boston, Mass. There is a title-page and a list of contents to each of the volumes, I-IX, and to vol. XII, lists of contents to vols. X, XI, and XIII, and paper wrappers to nos. 235-338, 347-349, 358, 374, 379, 382, 387, 392, 418, 429, 439, 470, 492, 496, 500, 516, 517, 522, 539, 571, 578, 578 and 636. There is a "Special convention number" for February 15, 1892, numbered "Vol. II. No. 53", a slip supplement to no. 338 and a supplement to no. 453. Nos. 1 and 2 are dated "1890" instead of "1891", nos. 562 and 568 are numbered "Vol. IX. No. 40" and "41" instead of "41" and "42," respectively, nos. 604-609 are numbered Vol. XVII. numbers 27-32 in place of 80-85, respectively, the wrappers of nos. 274 and 275 are wrongly numbered Vol. VII. numbers 13 and 14, instead of 14 and 15, respectively, and the wrapper of no. 318 is numbered "Vol. IX. no. 4" in place of no 5. An index to vol. XVI, was given in the number of June 25, 1910.
