Nos. 1-9 of the second year and all the numbers of the eighth, ninth, tenth, and eleventh years were produced by autographic lithography. Nos. 10 and 11 of the second year, nos. 2 and 3 and 9 and 10 of the third year, nos. 1 and 2, 5 and 6 and 9 and 10 of the fourth year, nos. 5 and 6, 7 and 8, 9 and 10 and 11 and 12 of the fifth year, nos. 6 and 7 and 8-10 of the eleventh year were severally published together. There are no numbers of the seventh year, no. 3 of the eighth year is dated "Mar. und Mai" and "Jun. und Juli".
