Nos. 2-4 of the second year and nos. 1-2 of the ninth year have the title "Mittheilungen des Briefmarkensammler-Vereins Mosel in Köln". Nos. 1-9 of the second year and all the ninth year, and parts tenth, eleventh, and eleventh years were produced by autographic lithography. Nos. 10-11 of the second year, nos. 2 and 3 and 9 and 10 of the third year, nos. 1 and 2, 6 and 7 and 11 and 12 of the fifth year, and nos. 6 and 7 and 8-10 of the eighth year were published by heliographic lithography. The no. 10 of the seventh year, nos. 3 of the eighth year is dated "Marz, April und Mai" and no. 4 "Juni-Dezember". Nos. 10 and 11 of the second year are wrongly numbered 14-15; nos. 7 and 8 of the third year are wrongly numbered 16-17; nos. 6 and 7 of the twelfth year are wrongly numbered 10.
