\* \* No. 1 was published at Stockholm, the next forty-seven numbers at Stockholm and Kristiania, the twenty numbers of the third year at Stockholm, nos. 69-68 at Kristiania, nos. 69-108 at Kjöbenhavn, nos. 109-128 at Stockholm, nos. 129-140 at Kristiania, nos. 141-154 at Kjöbenhavn, the twenty-four numbers of 1902 and 1903 at Lund, the numbers 1904 and 1905 at Kristiania and those of 1906 at Stockholm. Commencing with no. 2 of the fourth year the journal has been published by the Nordisk Filatelist Forbund. There is a title-page and an index to each volume and a paper wrapper to each number. The wrapper of no. 13 of the second year is dated "15 Juni" instead of "1 Juli," and there are no nos. 143 and 144, the number for March, 1903, being numbered "145," and this error in numbering was continued to the end of the year. No. 2 is also called "Nordisk Frimærkeblad." No. 26 "and" Tidning för Frimærkesamlare" and this title numbering is carried on to the end of 1895 when it is dropped. From January, 1897, the spelling of the title is amended to "Nordisk Filatelistisk Tidskrift". No. 12 of the twelfth year has also "No. 200".
