* There is a title-page and an index for each volume and a coloured paper wrapper to each number commencing with no. 1 of the second year. Commencing with no. 10 of the sixth year the journal has been published by Feodor Reinbold. No. 23 of the second year is wrongly numbered "24" on page 189. There are supplements with the titles "Die Briefmarken-Borse" and "Philatelistische Literatur," which are catalogued separately, a further supplement headed "Verzeich. Nachrichten," which runs through all the volumes and a supplement with the title "Dubletten-Markt," which was commenced in the number for May, 1905. There are two numbers for December, 1905, "Weihnachten, 1905" and "30 Dezember, 1905," and two editions of no. 1 of that year. In one of these the front paper wrapper is missing "1895" - "No. 1" at the foot, while the other has this numbering. A sample copy, for advertisement purposes, of no. 5, 1901, was issued and is bound up in Mts. St. Jour. 132 (10).
