

**BERGER-LEVRAULT** (FRANÇON GEORGE OSCAR) Beschreibung der bis jetzt bekannten Briefmarken . . . Strasburg, 1864. Add note: "Copies were also issued interleaved in stiff covers.

" Both parts are interleaved and there is no title-page, or index to the whole work, and it is not described in the Catalogue with the date 1865; appear to be advanced copies of a new edition in French, which were sent to sundry prominent collectors for them to correct errors and make additions to the lists before the definite work was published in 1867. Wanting. Copies of both parts are in the library of Mr. F. A. Bellamy of Oxford. These came from the library of Dr. A. Legrand of Paris.

1079 — Les Timbres-poste. Paris, 1867. [Edition with the "Avant-propos" dated "Juin, 1867."] Add to note: This edition is also found with the name and address of "Pierre Mahé" on the front wrapper, as well as that of "Va. Berger-Levrault & Cie" and also an advertisement of Pierre Mahé's own back wrapper. The date on this variety of wrapper is "1867." Copies of the "Juin, 1867" edition are known interleaved and bound in green morocco and were probably used for presentation purposes. One of this kind is in the library of Mr. F. A. Bellamy of Oxford. This came from the library of Dr. A. Legrand and contains numerous notes in his handwriting. Part II. of the 1867 edition, which was to have consisted of "Essais et timbres proposés" was never published.
