A REVISED EDITION OF THE CRAWFORD CATALOGUE

The Printer's Stone Limited, in association with the British Library, takes great pleasure in announcing a revised edition of the Crawford Catalogue, Catalogue of the Crawford Library of Philatelic Literature at the British Library. What makes this edition of utmost importance is the inclusion of the British Library shelfmarks. This permits, for the first time, easy identification of specific items whether for use in the British Library Reading Rooms or for reference citation. Originally published in 1991 as Vol. VII of Biblioteca Indesiana (under the title A Bibliography of the Writings General Special and Periodical forming the Literature of Philately), this is the pre-eminent reference for early philatelic literature (up to 1911). As James Negus has said in his new book Philatelic Literature, "...all serious bibliographic work starts with this unique catalogue. The citations and annotations to each entry are of remarkable depth and thoroughness; their bibliographic value is incomparable."

After completion of the 1911 bibliography, Sir Edward D. Bacon continued his work and produced a Supplement in 1926, published by the Philatelic Literature Society and an Addenda which appeared as a supplement to the March 1938 issue of the *London Philatelist*. These three works have been brought together into one volume, citing some 4,500 works. The master used for this production is Sir Edward's personal copy, annotated in his hand, with shelfmarks added by another.

Retained in the edition are the Earl's Introduction describing the development of his collection and Bacon's Preface detailing the use of his bibliography. A new preface by D.R. Beech, curator of Philatelic Collections at the British Library, brings these historical and technical matters up to date.

The 550 page hardbound folio Catalogue, printed on archival paper and Smythe sewn, is scheduled for publication in mid-September 1991 and will be limited to 500 copies. A sample page (somewhat reduced) is illustrated on the verso.

The price is US\$225 prepaid (add \$15 bank charge for non-US check) which includes surface posting to anywhere in the world. It may be ordered direct from The Printer's Stone Limited, Box 30, Fishkill, N.Y. 12524. Library and quantity discounts available.
