- Public and Private
 - Broadly applicable, or limited scope
- Public Acts later codified into the Revised Statutes and US Code
 - but these leave out the appropriations and other time-limited acts, so we (mostly) don't include them

Highlights

- Organizational acts, on a temporary basis
 - 22 Sep. 1789, ..., 3 Mar. 1791
- Organizational acts, on a permanent basis
 - 20 Feb. 1792, ..., 3 Mar. 1825, 3 Mar. 1845, etc.
- Flogging abolished in the Navy, 28 Sep. 1850

Highlights and Lowlights

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Lowlights

- Only free white persons may carry the mails
 - 3 May 1802, 30 Apr. 1810, 3 Mar. 1825; repealed, 3 Mar. 1865
- For want of a 5-cent revenue stamp ... , 27 July 1868
- The Comstock Act, 3 Mar. 1873
- Destruction of Post Office records authorized, 15 Mar. 1898

that every student of postal history needs to know

- Presidents and Congresses, 1789-1901
- States and Territories, 1787-1959
- Constitution and Amendments, 1787-1992
- Congressional session dates
- additional materials that might be interesting
 - House and Senate journals, Congressional Record, etc.
- Example 7 Aug. 1953, Ohio statehood

Treaties

from US Statutes at Large, 1845-1950, vol. 1-64

- Treaties establishing land acquisition and international boundaries, 1763-1900
- Indian Treaties with postal relevance, 1805-1868
- Additional material from US treaty series edited by Malloy (1910), Miller (1931-1948), Bevans (1968-1976)
- Since 1951, published in U. S. Treaties and Other International Agreements
- Example 15 June 1846, Oregon country divided, from vol. 9

Postal Conventions

from US Statutes at Large, 1845-1950, vol. 1-64

- Postal conventions, and commercial and diplomatic treaties with postal import, from 1844 to 1949
 - including many not published in the Statutes at Large
 - with references to treaty series from Belgium, Britain, Denmark, Netherlands, and Sweden,
 - and the Postmaster General's Reports
- Example 9 May 1871 through 27 July 1871, from vol. 17

Revenue Collection

1694-1902

- Stamp Office
- Stamped paper
- Stamp duties
- Revenue stamps

Coins, Paper Currency 1778-1901

- Mint, coinage
- Legal tender, National currency
- Foreign currency, exchange rates

Confederate States 1860-1870

- Secession dates
- Admission (to the Confederacy), Readmission (to the Union)
- State-level documents, secession conventions and ordinances, initial provisions for postal services
- Confederate postal legislation, Provisional Government
- Confederate postal legislation, Permanent Government
 - more than in Dietz and other philatelic sources
