Chap. 334.—An act prohibiting the publication of the Revised Statutes of the United States in the newspapers at the expense of the United States

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the revised Statutes of the United States and no part thereof shall be published in the newspapers not to be published at the expense of the United States. at the expense of the United States.
