CHAP. 244.—An act granting a Pension to Melissa Rankin.

March 3, 1875.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to place upon the pension-roll, subject to the provisions and limitations of the pension laws, the name of Melissa Rankin, mother of Oliver S. Rankin, a lieutenant in the tenth regiment Indiana volunteers, and pay her a pension at the rate of eight dollars a month, from and after the passage of this act.

CHAP. 245.—An act for the relief of Nelson Green.

March 3, 1875.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Postmaster General be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to release Nelson Green of Bay City, Michigan, mail contractor on mail routes twenty-four thousand three hundred and sixty-six, being from Granton to Au Sable, and twenty-four thousand three hundred and sixty-seven, from Alpina to Au Sable, in the said State of Michigan from the performance of said service.

Nelson Green released from mail contract.

CHAP. 246.—An act granting a Pension to Mrs. Sophia Green.

March 3, 1875.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to place upon the pension-roll, subject to the provisions and limitations of the pension laws, the name of Mrs. Sophia Green, widow of Harvey Green, late a private in company C, tenth regiment Vermont Volunteers, and pay her a pension from and after the passage of this act.

CHAP. 247.—An act granting a Pension to Louis Heinley.

March 3, 1875.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to place upon the pension-roll, subject to the provisions and limitations of the pension laws, the name of Louis Heinley, late of Company B, Twelfth Regiment Pennsylvania Cavalry, and pay him a pension from and after the passage of this act.
