<i>Chile.</i> Protocol of an agreement between the United States of America and the Republic of Chile in regard to the claim of Patrick Shields. Signed at Washington, May 24, 1897.....	1596
<i>Honduras, postal.</i> Parcels post convention between the United States of America and Honduras, approved July 18, 1896.....	1597
<i>Honduras, money orders.</i> Convention between the United States of America and Honduras for the exchange of money orders.....	1607
<i>Egypt, money orders.</i> Convention for the exchange of money orders between the United States of America and Egypt.....	1613
<i>Mexico, water boundary.</i> Convention between the United States of America and the United States of Mexico, extending for a period of one year from December 24, 1897, the duration of the convention between the two high contracting parties of March 1, 1889, concerning the water boundary between the two countries. Signed at Washington October 29, 1897; ratification advised by the Senate December 16, 1897; ratified by the President of the United States December 20, 1897; ratified by the President of Mexico November 2, 1897; ratifications exchanged at Washington December 21, 1897; proclaimed December 21, 1897.....	1625
<i>Universal Postal Union.</i> Convention signed at Washington June 15, 1897.....	1629
<i>Chile.</i> Convention for the exchange of money orders, signed at Washington August 12, 1897....	1739
<i>Spain.</i> Protocol of agreement, embodying the terms of a basis for the establishment of peace, signed at Washington August 12, 1898.....	1742
