

**CHAP. 507**—An Act Granting a pension to Clara R. Rodgers.

June 27, 1898.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to place on the pension roll, subject to the provisions and limitations of the pension laws, the name of Clara R. Rodgers, widow of Robert Edwin Rodgers, late major Fourth Ohio Cavalry, and pay her a pension at the rate of twenty-five dollars per month.*

**CHAP. 508.**—An Act Increasing the pension of Corriassanda L. McGuire.

June 27, 1898.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to place on the pension roll, subject to the provisions and limitations of the pension laws, the name of Corriassanda L. McGuire, widow of James E. McGuire, who served in Company B of the Second Kentucky Regiment Infantry in the war with Mexico; who also served as captain of Company F, Fifty-first Regiment Indiana Infantry Volunteers, and pay to her a pension of twenty dollars per month, in lieu of any pension that may now be paid her.*

**CHAP. 509.**—An Act For the relief of Lizzie Hagny, as administratrix of the estate of Frank B. Smith, deceased.

June 27, 1898.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Lizzie Hagny, as administratrix of the estate of Frank B. Smith, deceased, the sum of one thousand two hundred and thirty-seven dollars and fifty-two cents, being the amount expended by said Frank B. Smith for clerk hire in excess of his allowance during his incumbency as postmaster at Wichita, Kansas, from October first, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, to June thirtieth, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven.*

**CHAP. 510.**—An Act Granting an increase of pension to Blanche E. Barlow.

June 27, 1898.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to place on the pension roll, subject to the provisions and limitations of the pension laws, the name of Blanche E. Barlow, widow of the late A. C. Barlow, surgeon Fourth West Virginia Volunteer Infantry and Sixty-second Ohio Volunteer Infantry, and pay her a pension at the rate of seven-teen dollars per month in lieu of the pension she is now receiving.*
