#### STATUTE I.-1836.

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No. 13. Reduction of Postage, &c. Joint resolution to fix the time when the act to reduce the rates of postage, to limit the use and correct the abuse of the franking privilege, and for the prevention of frands on the revenues of the Post-Office Department, passed at this session, shall go into effect. March 3, 1845	
No. 14. Defaults by States in the Payment of Interest or Principal of Investments on Bonds, held by the United States. A joint resolution directing the Secretary of the Treasury, whenever any State shall have been or may be in default for the payment of interest or principal on investments in its stocks or bonds held by the United States in trust, to retain certain moneys to which such State is entitled for the purposes therein named. March 3, 1845.	
No. 15. Additional Inspectors at the Port of New Orleans. A resolution authorizing the employment of additional Inspectors of the Customs at the port of New Orleans. March 3, 1845
